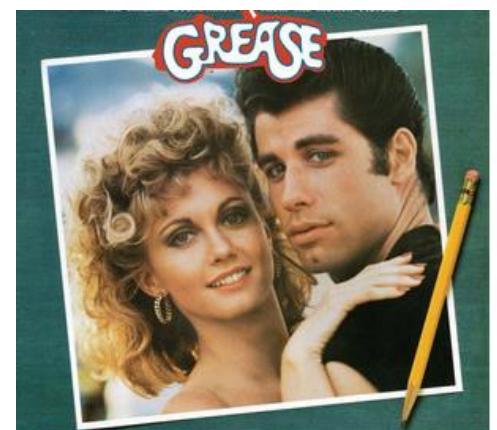

**Runs on:** Mondays

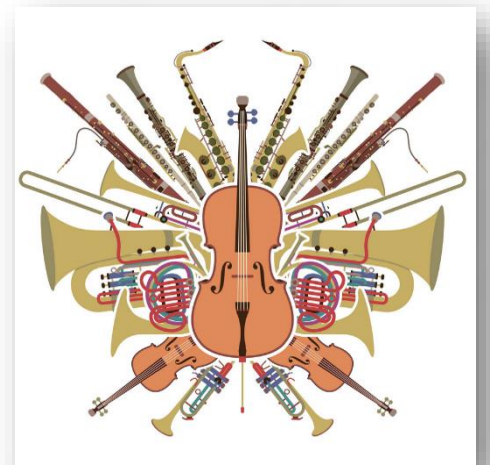

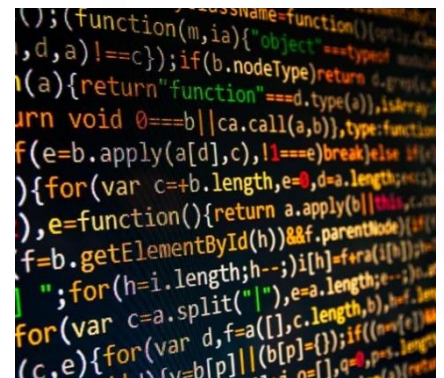

**Runs on:** Tuesdays

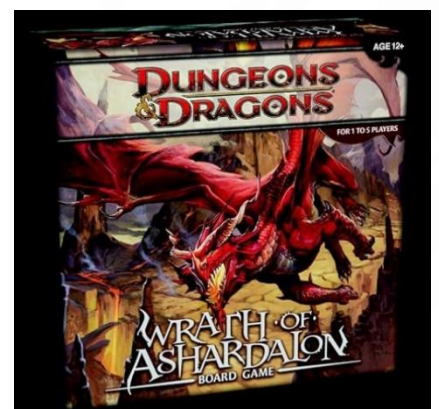

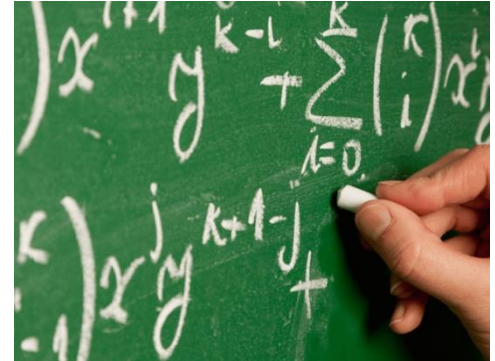

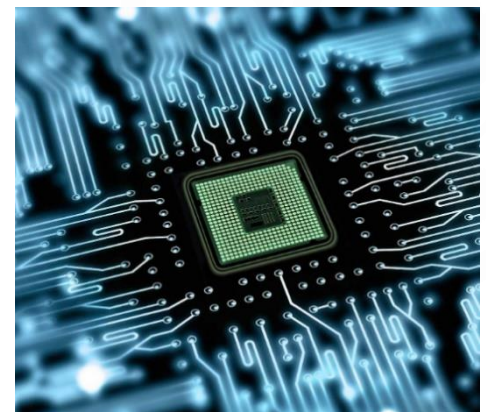
